



INDOOR GATHERINGS ARE LIMITED TO 25% CAPACITY OR 100 PEOPLE..

THESE LIMITS PRESUME STRICT ADHERENCE TO SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES WHICH REQUIRE SIX (6) FEET OF DISTANCE BETWEEN INDIVIDUALS AND HOUSEHOLDS. HOUSEHOLDS MAY SIT TOGETHER.
